## Notes

1. The requirement to be on the electoral roll of the parish for at least the preceding six months does not apply to those under the age of eighteen years.
2. 'Actual communicant' means a person who has received communion according to the use of the Church of England or a Church in communion with it at least three times during the 12 months before his or her election, has his or her name on the church electoral roll of the parish and is either confirmed or ready and desirous of being confirmed or receiving Holy Communion in accordance with Canon B15A.1(b) (which relates to communicant members in good standing of other Churches which subscribe to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity).
3. A person is disqualified from being a member of the parochial church council if:-
  - a. he or she is disqualified from being a charity trustee under section 178 of the Charities Act 2011 (visit <http://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukpga/2011/25/section/178>), and the disqualification is not for the time being subject to a waiver by the Charity Commission under section 181 of that Act;
  - b. the person is included in a barred list (within the meaning of the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006);
  - c. the person has been convicted of an offence mentioned in Schedule 1 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933;  
(A person's disqualification under this paragraph may be waived by the bishop of the diocese in question giving the person notice in writing.
  - d. he or she is disqualified from holding office under section 10(6) of the Incumbents (Vacation of Benefices) Measure 1977 (Section 2(1), (2) and (3)).
4. No person shall be nominated for election to serve on the deanery synod unless he has signified his consent to serve, or there is in the opinion of the meeting sufficient evidence of his willingness to serve.
